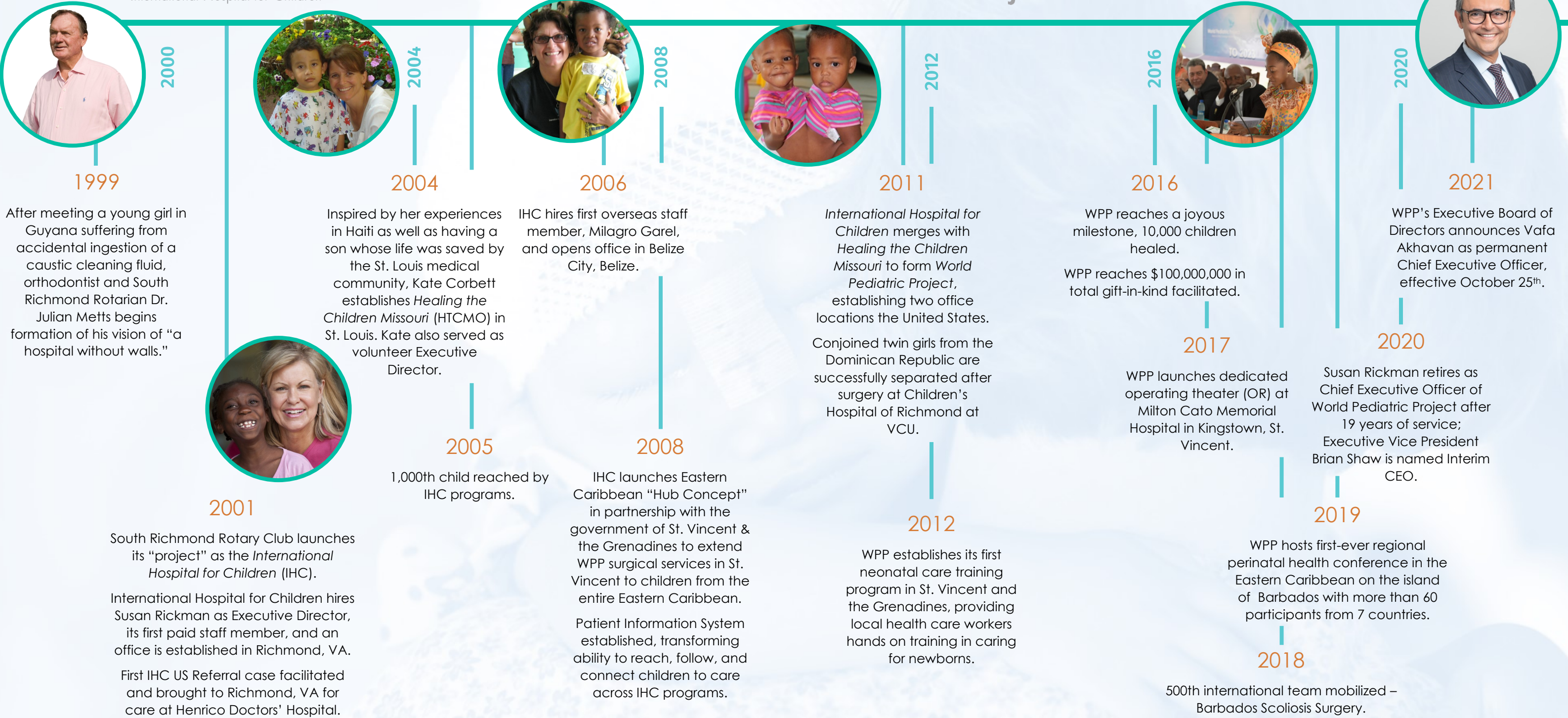

EASTERN CARIBBEAN ORTHOPEDIC PROGRAM

In June 2021, the beautiful island nation of St. Lucia became home to our newest orthopedic surgery team, which included the vital components of physical therapy and orthotics. Nearly 100 children were seen by this veteran team, led by Dr. Eric Gordon of Shriners Hospital/St. Louis Children's Hospital. The team worked at the sparkling new Owen King European University Hospital in Castries. Team members worked closely with partner adult orthopedic surgeons from St. Lucia, Dr. Haden Alcindor and Dr. Horatius Jeffers.

Orthopedic surgeries and evaluations were complemented by crucial physical therapy services and orthotics.

This team is the newest surgical component of WPP's Eastern Caribbean Orthopedic Program, which consists of diagnostic clinics and surgery teams across 6 islands and supporting physical therapy, bracing and orthotics services, reaching 500+ children each year.

World Pediatric Project will continue to expand its virtual conferences for perinatal caregivers in the Eastern Caribbean. Virtual training clinics in the last year reached more than 400 health workers from 6 countries, These trainings cover a range of topics to help improve outcomes for vulnerable newborns, including respiratory management and better treatment for low birthweight.

PARTNER HIGHLIGHT



The neonatology team at SSM Health Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital/ Saint Louis University in St. Louis, MO has provided critical leadership and vision for the WPP Eastern Caribbean Neonatal Training Program. Led by Dr. Robert Fleming (pictured), the team's commitment ensured that the program maintained its momentum throughout the pandemic. This team of volunteers led dozens of virtual workshops, conferences, and trainings, allowing the program to continue to grow even when training teams could not travel. The Eastern Caribbean Neonatal Training Program is currently active in 6 countries, reaching hundreds of healthcare workers and fragile newborn babies each year.

World Pediatric Project's diagnostic scoliosis clinics will conduct their first visits to Dominica and Antigua. The regional program will continue to expand including a general orthopedic surgical team scheduled to travel to Dominica led by Dr. Chester Sharps.

279 children were served by WPP programs in Central America, receiving 410 total services including surgeries, procedures, consultations and therapies during FY2021.



5-year-old Damaris from Guatemala was one of 7 children able to receive prosthetic care closer to home, thanks to new collaborations with regional resources in Central America.



REGIONAL REFERRAL PROGRAM

WPP's Regional Referral Program in Central America connects dozens of children each year to specialty services closer to home, and in doing so also supports the livelihoods and capacity of local pediatric specialists in these communities.

Dr. Juan Craniotis, a Honduran pediatric general surgeon who has partnered with international groups for many years, coordinated a local surgical brigade to take care of a large volume of patients awaiting care. Despite securing a reduced rate per surgery, the cost was still prohibitive for most low-income Honduran families. WPP stepped in to support 12 children to receive surgery from this local brigade.

IN THE COMING YEAR...



Three orthopedic spine teams are scheduled to travel to Honduras in 2022 to provide diagnostic and surgical care.

Two Honduran professionals will receive training in neuromonitoring, a critical element of spine surgery that currently has no trained professionals available locally.

This last year WPP worked with volunteer and intraoperative neuromonitoring tech Lauren Feltz (right) to help secure equipment and begin to coordinate training at Ruth Paz Hospital in San Pedro Sula, Honduras to develop an independent neuromonitoring department.

This is part of Mark’s story who was born with spina bifida (when the spine and spinal cord don’t form properly), dislocated hips and bilateral clubfoot. Through WPP’s international network, Mark was connected to WPP when he was just a baby. He traveled twice from

Belize for lengthy treatment at Shriners Hospital for Children - St. Louis.

After multiple surgeries, and a lot of hard work on Mark’s part as well as his host family and extraordinary medical team, those first steps were taken just before his 5th birthday. There was not a dry eye in the room.

Helping families who travel hundreds of miles to care in the United States can be difficult enough - more so when facing the impact of COVID-19. For the 11 families in St. Louis for care at the start of the pandemic and 6 more who traveled over the last year, WPP U.S. Referral Program Director Natalia Rosales was there, working tirelessly to ensure families remained safe while keeping treatment for the children going.

“Hiring Natalia in 2010 was probably the best professional decision I have ever made,” says Kate Corbett, WPP Senior Program Director - U.S. Referral Program. “She is passionate, mission-centered and works tirelessly as an enthusiastic advocate for every child under her care. YOUR SUPPORT

2020-2021 FINANCIAL SUMMARY

The impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on World Pediatric Project has been both immediate and lasting.

The immediate impact - WPP was on track for a record-setting year, both in funds raised and delivered care until air travel was drastically eliminated, healthcare institutions reached max capacity and unprecedented border closures led to a cancelation of nearly all of WPP's programs in spring of 2020. Furthermore, financial uncertainty led to donor apprehension and government restrictions led to cancelled or postponed special events.

Children awaiting care with one of WPP's traveling medical teams now had to wait for care, in some cases as their conditions worsened. WPP rushed to reschedule many children who needed to travel to the United States for surgery, working with our partners to prioritize the most urgent cases and expanding our global network to connect children with care where available. Local care in our partner

countries, already stretched thin in some areas, was further strained as healthcare systems prioritized COVID-19 cases over less urgent but still necessary care.

The lasting impact - For some children, conditions that may have been more easily treated in 2020 have now progressed to require more invasive surgery. The already-lengthy waiting list of children seeking specialty care from WPP has only grown. Despite WPP adapting and expanding our network and model of care to reach as many children as possible, the gap in access to quality, critical pediatric care has only grown.

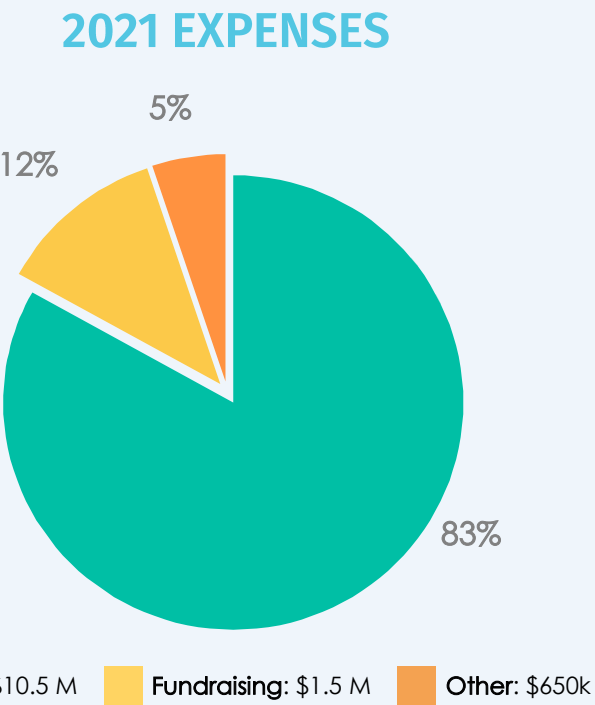
